## DOWN TO EARTH

**HUMILITY.** The Hebrew word for wonders.

humble is 'anav' and means 'to afflict, strike down, bring low'. It refers to one who through afflictions have learned to be humble and dependent on God.

The Hebrew word 'anavah' translated as humility literally means 'to occupy your God-given space in the world' — to not overestimate yourself or your abilities, but to not underestimate them either.

**HUMBLE** is made up of three Hebrew letters:

**Ayin:** described as two eyes on a brain stem and means 'to see, to behold' and by extension to understand and obey.

**Nun:** described as a man bent over with a crown on his head and represents servanthood.

**Hei:** spirit, wind. It also represents the number 50 which stands for breakthrough, miracles, signs, and

**THE** word humble might be described as 'understand and obey servanthood as we yield to the Spirit to have breakthrough.'

*"So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. For the flesh desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the flesh. They are in conflict with each other, so that you are not to do whatever you want. But if you are led by the Spirit you are not under the law."*  
**Galatians 5:16-18**

**GREEK:** making oneself low to the ground.

**ENGLISH:** from Latin 'humilis' meaning low from the root word 'humus' meaning the ground or earth. The dictionary defines humility as having or showing a modest or low estimate of one's own importance, unpretentious, down to earth.

definitions of humble we see that low/ ground/ earth is a common theme.

**Down** to earth seems a reasonable definition from these three languages and is not an uncommon phrase most of us are familiar with. If you have been told you are down to earth it is a compliment. What they are saying is you don't have an air of superiority; you are real and without pretension and practical.

Does the Bible have anything to say about being down to earth?

*"Don't push your way to the front; don't sweet-talk your way to the top. Put yourself aside, and help others get ahead. Don't be obsessed with getting your own advantage. Forget yourselves long enough to lend a helping hand. Think of yourselves the way*

**HUMILITY**

*Jesus Christ thought of himself. He had equal status with God but didn't think so much of himself that he had to cling to the advantages of that status no matter what.*

*Not at all. When the time came, he set aside the privileges of deity and took on the status of a servant, became human! Having become human, he stayed human. It was an incredibly humbling process. He didn't claim special privileges. Instead, he lived a selfless, obedient life and then died a selfless, obedient death—and the worst kind of death at that—a crucifixion." **Philippians 2:4-8***

**Now** that is a picture of not having an air of superiority. Jesus is our example – talk about a man bowing with a crown on his head. As C.S. Lewis said, "Humility is not thinking less of yourself, it's thinking of yourself less." Real and without pretension. The Pharisees were the great pretenders – outward appearances mattered more than who they were inwardly. We are instructed in James to get real with one another – 'confess our faults (failure, sin, missing the

mark) and pray for one another that we may be healed.'

The Word says '*Be angry and sin not*' but many of us have stuffed our anger or other emotions down inside, as supposedly it is not very Christian to expose them, then we wonder why so many are depressed, critical, experience fits of rage and anxiety. It is so important to find someone you can get real with and work through your struggles. The devil works in the dark. It is humbling to confess to another person our struggles....But oh, so freeing!

**JESUS** was real – He wept over Lazarus and Jerusalem, he showed His anger at the religious and in His anguish at Gethsemane, said to Peter "*Couldn't you watch with me even one hour?*" He hung out with outcasts and sinners and was known as a friend of sinners. His disciples pushed away little children, maybe finding them annoying and insignificant but Jesus took them in his arms.

How about practical? Who would think that being practical has anything to do with humility?

*"But if anyone has the world's goods and sees his brother in need, yet closes his heart against him, how does God's love abide in him? Little children, let us not love in word or talk but in deed and in truth."*

**John 3:17-18**

A religious spirit cares about appearance and rules and earning our salvation = self, self, self = pride, pride, pride!

*Pure and unblemished religion [as it is expressed in outward acts] in the sight of our God and Father is this: to visit and look after the fatherless and the widows in their distress, and to keep oneself uncontaminated by the [secular] world." **James 1:27***

So, how about it... let's get down to earth!

# THE EYE OF THE EAGLE VISION!

**G**OD is anointing the mature Eagles (Prophets) to be like watchmen and serve to bring protection and covering for the young emerging prophetic voices and communities that need guidance. I keep seeing in my Spirit the Eye of the Eagle watching over us.

Take note that the 4th face of the living creature (Cherubim) is an eagle in flight. As God's children, we too can also take refuge in His protection and care, knowing He watches over us and shields us from harm. Eagles are always alert, vigilant, and prepared for what lies ahead.

God sees everything that's happening in our lives. Like the Eagle His watchful eyes are always upon us, guiding and protecting us in ways that we may not even realize. The presence of eagles in the Bible serves as a powerful reminder of God's sovereignty and protection.

**THE EAGLE ALSO REPRESENTS THE PROPHETS** and prophetic seers which are rising up again even as the eagle rises up, will be even stronger in these last days.

**Isaiah 40:31** – *“But those who wait on the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint.”*

In scripture eagles are seen as metaphors or symbolic for God's protection, deliverance, guidance, and love for His people, as in (Exodus 19:4) We also see how eagles are used to describe the strength and agility of believers who wait on the Lord

## VISION LIKE EAGLES!

We will have to have the “eyes of the eagle” to see. Eagles eye vision will give you extraordinary clarity and sharpness to every spiritual vision. Eagles also see colors as more vivid than we do they see ultraviolet light, but we have no idea what it looks like to them, they see an absolutely beautiful world and that color differentiation is one of their great visual strengths.

Eagles are known for their sharp keen eyesight and ability to see from great distances. In (Proverbs 30:18-19, the eagle's way of moving through the air symbolizes the importance of seeing beyond our immediate circumstances and gaining a higher perspective and counsel.

God is going to open and enlighten the EYES of our heart with understanding so that we can know the HOPE of his calling for us. (Eph 1:18)

### BICYCLE CHAIN TRAFFICKER AUGUST 29, 2022

Rashmi and Beena (names changed for privacy), girls aged 16 and 17, were studying in school and also worked odd jobs to earn money for their families. Beena's dream was to join law enforcement and Rashmi wanted to become a teacher. The two girls rode their bikes to school every day, parking and chaining them just outside the building and then walking into classes.



One day, one of the girls' bicycle chains came off and out of nowhere, a man came up and offered to help fix it. Then he started to ask where they lived and what they wanted to do when they grew up. After hearing Beena and Rashmi's answers, the man told them they would have a better chance at getting successful jobs in those careers if they went to Lucknow.

"He's right," the girls thought, "We will go talk to our parents about letting us study in Lucknow to get a job." They thanked the man for his help with the bike and for his advice, telling him that they will talk to their parents about going to Lucknow. "I could take you to your parent's house now," the man said, "and after that we will go to Lucknow and get you a job." The girls were very innocent, and didn't think this man would harm them since he was being so helpful. So they agreed to go with the man. The kidnapper didn't take them home, but took them straight to Lucknow. His plan was to sell them into sex slavery.

The girls' parents filed a police report, and WIN's legal team was notified and immediately went to work to investigate their whereabouts in collaboration with the Lucknow police force which scoured the city and searched video clips from concealed cameras. After two months, the girls were located and rescued. They had been abused sexually and physically by the trafficker and had been used for sex during those two months in Lucknow. They are now back with their families. WIN's anti-trafficking coordinator keeps in touch with them and is providing counsel, and they are now finding healing and returning to a normal life.

The trafficker escaped and police are still trying to capture him. This case brings to light the horrors of trafficking and how easy it can be for kidnappers to abduct young girls. If you can, please help us protect these children by donating to WIN.

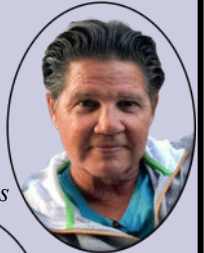

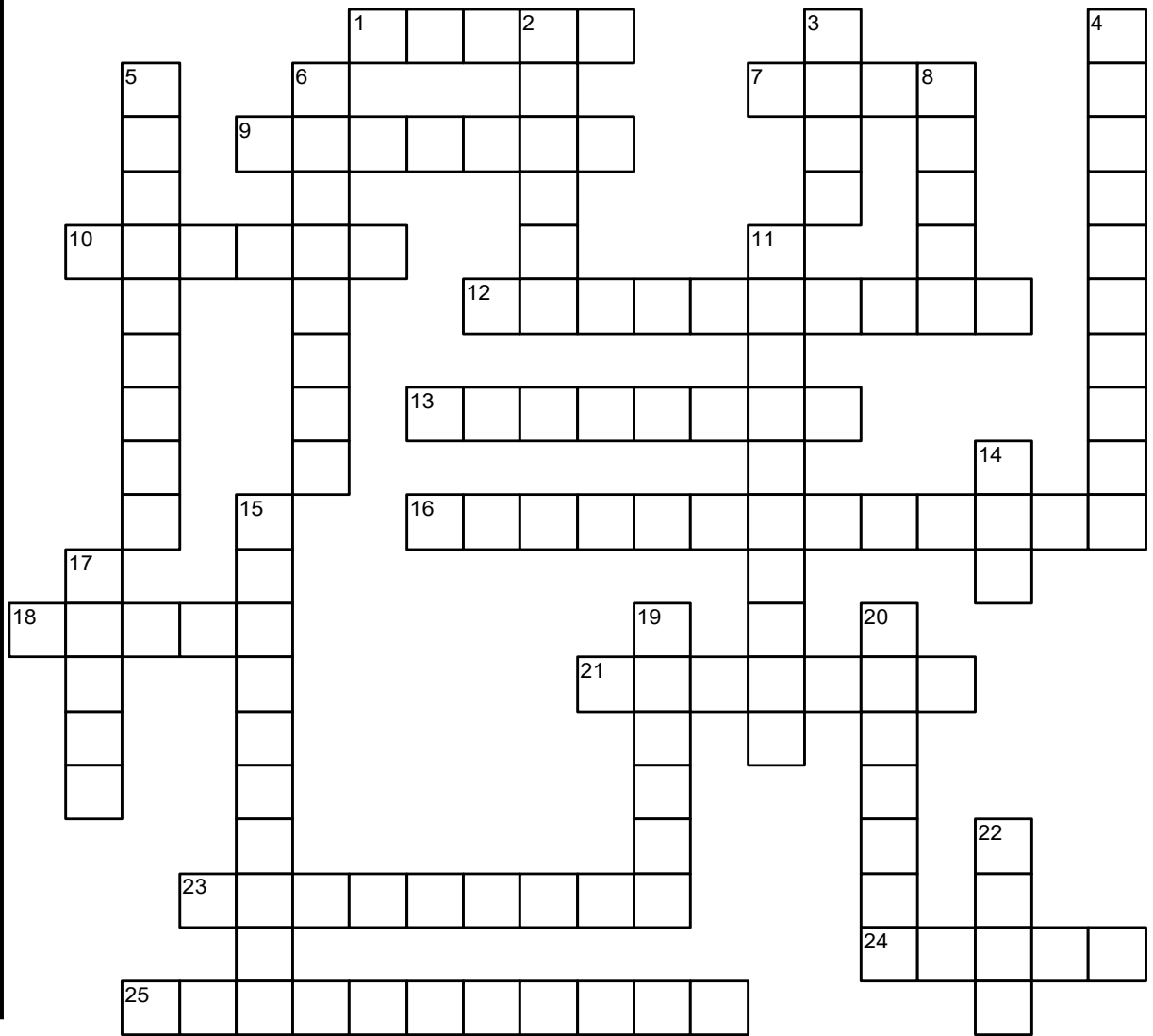
